## **Bright & Beautiful Curtain Fold Card**





## Supplies Needed:

Night of Navy ink
Night of Navy cardstock (base)
Basic White cardstock
Shimmer vellum
Bright & Beautiful designer series paper
Zoo Crew designer series paper
Sentiment stamp

All That dies Large scallop circle punch 2 3/8" punch Adhesive-backed sequins Dimensionals Adhesives

## General Measurements:

Card base

Bright & Beautiful DSP

Inside sentiment panel

4 ¼" x 11" Night of Navy cardstock scored at 3 3/8" and 7 5/8" 3 1/8" x 5 ¼" (x2) 2 ½" x 4" 4" x 5 ¼" Basic White cardstock

## Directions:

- 1. Cut Night of Navy cardstock  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x 11". Score at 3 3/8" and 7 5/8". When folded, the center panel should be  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 2. With the long edge of the cardstock down, make a pencil mark at 3 ¾" on the left and make a pencil mark at 1" from the edge on the bottom. Repeat on the right side. The marks should be mirrors on each side.
- 3. Cut diagonally from the 1" mark to the 3 ¾" mark on each side of the card. Each flap should be an identical mirror of the other and will overlap when folded.
- 4. Cut Basic White cardstock 4" x 5 1/4" and adhere to inside of card.
- 5. Select your Bright & Beautiful designer series paper (DSP) patterns.
- 6. Cut 2 a ¾" x 4" strip of DSP and a 2" x 4" strip of DSP. Adhere the smaller strip behind the larger so that about ½" is visible at the top. Adhere this DSP panel at the bottom of the white cardstock inside the card.
- 7. Cut 2 pieces of DSP 3 1/8" x 5 1/4". Decide which piece is the left/right panel when the card is closed.
- 8. With the DSP face up as it will appear on the card front, on the left panel, make a pencil mark 1" from the top right corner and another mark 1 5/8" up from the bottom right corner. Cut on the diagonal between the two pencil marks. The DSP should have a border around it when placed on the card front. Adhere to the left panel of the card front.
- 9. With the DSP face up as it will appear on the card front, on the right panel, make a pencil mark 1" from the top left corner and another mark 1 5/8" up from the bottom left corner. Cut on the diagonal between the two pencil marks. The DSP should have a border around it when placed on the card front. Adhere to the right panel of the card front.
- 10. Using the circle punch, select and punch a character from the Zoo Crew DSP.
- 11. Using the scallop circle, punch a scalloped circle from shimmer vellum.
- 12. Using the square from the All That die set, diecut from shimmer vellum. Stamp a sentiment in the center. All the ink to dry and then adhere in the center of the DSP panel on the inside of the card.
- 13. Embellish the card with Wink of Stella and sequins as desired.
