Standard Barn Fold Card





Supplies Needed:

Versamark, Lost Lagoon ink Lost Lagoon cardstock (base) Vellum One Horse Open Sleigh designer series paper Magical Meadow stamps

General Measurements:

Card base

Vellum A Walk in the Forest DSP

White paper

All That dies Clear embossing powder Faceted gems Silver & White sheer ribbon Adhesive-backed sequins Adhesives

5 ½" x 8 ½" Lost Lagoon cardstock scored at 2 1/8" from each short edge 2" x 2 ½"
2" x 5 3/8" (x2) (tree scene)
4" x 5 3/8" (cabin scene)
2" x 5 3/8" (cabin scene)

Directions:

- 1. Cut 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Lost Lagoon cardstock for card base. With the long edge on the bottom, score at 2 $\frac{1}{8}$ " from edge of each short side. Fold panels toward the center. You should have a standard 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " panel on the inside of the card which is covered by two 2 $\frac{1}{8}$ " panels (your barn doors).
- 2. Select two patterns from the One Horse Open Series designer series paper pack. For this design, I selected a snowy tree scene and the cabin scene.
- 3. From the tree scene, cut 2 pieces 2" x 5 3/8".
- 4. Affix each piece of DSP to the outer-facing small panels of the card base so that, when the card is closed, the two pieces of DSP comprise a solid pattern facing outward.
- 5. From the cabin scene, cut 1 piece 2" x 5 3/8" and set aside the other portion of this sheet of DSP. Affix this 2" piece to the inward-facing small panel on the right side of the card base.
- 6. Affix the 4" x 5 3/8" piece of the cabin scene to the inside center panel of the card base. The two pieces of DSP should make a complete scene on the right side of the card base.
- 7. Next, cut a piece of white cardstock or paper 2" x 5 3/8". Select and stamp the sentiment in Lost Lagoon on this piece. Affix the sentiment panel on the small panel on the left side of the card base.
- 8. Embellish with sequins as desired.
- 9. Cut the front-facing sentiment panel from the vellum using the All That die.
- 10. Stamp and emboss the front sentiment on the vellum.
 - TIP: Color match the embossed sentiment to the card base color by coating the sentiment stamp with Versamark first and then covering with your selected ink color (Lost Lagoon here). Next, coat with clear embossing powder and then heat set. Your embossed sentiment will now be the color of the selected ink.
- 11. Pull enough sheer ribbon to make into a bow shape large enough to cover most of the front of the card but do not tie. Instead, hold the ribbon in the shape of the bow on the left panel by placing a strip of tear tape over the ribbon.
- 12. Remove the tear tape backing and place the vellum sentiment panel on top. Press well to adhere the tape to all layers.
- 13. Embellish the outside of the card with gems as desired.
