Peek-Through Fun Fold Card



Supplies Needed:

Flirty Flamingo, Melon Mambo ink Blushing Bride cardstock (base) Basic White cardstock Country Floral Lane designer series paper Heartfelt Hexagon, Charming Sentiments stamps Heartfelt Hexagon punch Adhesive-backed sequins Dimensionals Adhesives

General Measurements:

Card base

Basic White cardstock Country Floral Lane DSP White paper

Directions:

 $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 11" Blushing Bride cardstock scored at 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from each short edge $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " 4" x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " 4" x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ "

1. Cut $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x 11" Blushing Bride cardstock. Score at $5\frac{1}{2}$ " from the short edge so that your card fold will be at the top of your card base when folded.

- 2. Next cut 1" from the bottom of the card base so that the long edge now measures 10". There should be a 1" gap at the bottom of your card front when the card is closed.
- 3. Select a DSP with a pattern that lends itself well to a peek-through design. This can be a repeating pattern, like the bicycle sheet here, or a scenic sheet.
- 4. Cut the DSP to 4" x 5 1/4". Then cut 1" from the bottom and set this strip aside. Your larger piece of DSP should now measure 4" x 4 1/4".

NOTE: When using 6" x 6" DSP, I reserve the 2" strip to affix to the flap of the envelope in order to have a fully coordinating set.

- 5. Affix the 4" x 4 1/4" DSP sheet to the front of the card base.
- 6. Affix the 4" x5 1/4" white paper to the inside of the card base. Then affix the 1" strip of DSP to the bottom of the white paper so that the DSP is visible at the bottom when the card is closed.
- 7. Stamp the hexagon and sentiment on white cardstock and then punch out using the hexagon punch.
- 8. Place dimensionals on the back of the sentiment panel and affix to the center of the card front.
- 9. Embellish with sequins as desired.
