Curtain Fold Fun Fold Card



Supplies Needed:

Mossy Meadow, Basic White cardstock Joyful, Distressed Gold DSP So Sincere stamps Pretty Peacock ink

General Measurements:

Card base

Joyful DSP A Walk in the Forest DSP Distressed Gold DSP White cardstock Very Vanilla and gold satin-edged ribbon Neutrals sequins Dimensionals Adhesives

5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Mossy Meadow cardstock scored at 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " 4" x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " 10" x 5 3/8"

Directions:

- 1. Cut 5 ½" x 8 ½" Mossy Meadow cardstock. Score at 4 ¼".
- 2. Select background designer series paper that coordinates with the DSP being used for the curtain fold. In this case, Joyful is being used. Cut to $4" \times 5 \frac{1}{4}"$ and adhere to card base.
- 3. Select a sheet of DSP to be used for the curtain fold. In this case, a sheet of A Walk in the Forest is being used. Cut to 10° x 5° 3/8".
- 4. Next, with the long side on the top of the trimmer, score the DSP at 1", $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", $2\frac{1}{2}$ ", 3", 4", $4\frac{1}{2}$ ", $5\frac{1}{2}$ ", 6", 7", $7\frac{1}{2}$ ", $8\frac{1}{2}$ " and 9".
- 5. On each of the long sides, mark the DSP at $4\frac{1}{2}$ " and $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 6. On each of the short sides, mark the DSP at 2 3/8" and 3 3/8".
- 7. On the cutting edge of the trimmer, line up each set of pencil marks and cut on the diagonal. When cutting between each set of marks is complete, the DSP will roughly be a diamond shape.
- 8. With the widest width of the DSP running from left to right, work your way from each edge to the center of the DSP panel folding the scored lines in alternating directions to form pleats. Use adhesive to hold each fold down in place. (I found tear-n-tape the easiest and neatest way to adhere each pleat.)
- 9. Size the pleated DSP to the card front. I chose to have a small border around each of the four edges. Trim as necessary to your desired fit on the card front. Adhere the pleated DSP to the card front.
- 10. Diecut a banner from Distressed Gold DSP using the Nested Essentials banner die.
- 11. Diecut a sentiment panel from white cardstock using the Nested Essentials dies. Stamp your desired sentiment on the panel using Pretty Peacock ink.
- 12. Adhere the sentiment panel to the banner. Adhere the entire panel to the center of the card front using dimensionals.
- 13. Tie a small bow using the Very Vanilla and gold satin-edged ribbon and adhere to the center of the banner using a glue dot.
- 14. Embellish the card front with sequins as desired.
