Cut and Twist Fun Fold Tutorial



Supplies Needed:

Blackberry Bliss, Very Vanilla, Lost Lagoon, Bubble Bath, Berry Burst cardstock Vellum Perennial Lavender designer series paper Pretty Peacock ink Perennial Postage stamps

Painted Lavender, Thoughtful Expressions dies Pool Party crinkle ribbon Blooming pearls Dimensionals Adhesives

General Measurements:

4 1/4" x 11"

2 3/8" x 4 1/8'
2 7/8" x 4 1/8'
1 ¼" x 4 1/8"
1 ½" x 2 ½"
1 ¾ " x 3"
4 1/8" x 5 3/8'

Directions:

- 1. Cut $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x 11" Blackberry Bliss cardstock. Score at $5\frac{1}{2}$ ". Then line up the long edge at the top of the paper trimmer and cut at 3". This 3" layer becomes the "twist" layer. Set aside.
- 2. Select 3 different patterns from the Perennial Lavender designer series paper pack. For this design, I selected scaled down patterns that went from large to medium to small.
- 3. Cut the largest DSP pattern to 2 3/8" x 4 1/8" and adhere to the front card flap which is now on the left. NOTE: Ensure that the pattern runs correctly for a card in landscape orientation.
- 4. Cut the 2nd DSP pattern to 2 7/8" x 4 1/8". Adhere the DSP to the 3" landscape panel of Blackberry Bliss cardstock. Line up the right edge of this panel with the right edge of the card base, then adhere to the center of the front card flap.
- 5. Cut 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" basic white cardstock and adhere to the inside card base to serve as the message panel.
- 6. Cut the 3rd DSP pattern to 1 ¼" x 4 1/8" and adhere to the far right side of the message panel, ensuring that there is a 1/8" border of Blackberry Bliss on the right side of the strip of DSP.
- 7. Cut the sentiment panel from Very Vanilla cardstock using the Thoughtful Expressions dies. Stamp the sentiment from the Perennial Postage stamp set in the center in Pretty Peacock ink.
- 8. Cut the sentiment panel mat from vellum using the coordinating nesting Thoughtful Expressions dies and adhere the sentiment panel to the vellum mat.
- 9. Using the double stem die from the Painted Lavender die set, diecut once each from Lost Lagoon, Berry Burst, and Bubble Bath cardstock. Arrange the stems in a bunch behind the sentiment panel and adhere to the back of the sentiment panel using tear-n-tape, making sure it isn't visible through the vellum.
- 10. Using dimensionals, adhere the sentiment panel and stems to the 3" panel so that the bunched stems are to the far right of the card but not over either card edge.
- 11. Using Lost Lagoon crinkle ribbon, tie a knotted ribbon over the adjoining DSPs between the card base and the 3" panel.
- 12. Embellish with Pretty Peacock and Petal Pink blooming pearls.
