Window Z-Fold Fun Fold Tutorial





Supplies Needed:

Highland Heather, Gorgeous Grape, Basic White cardstock

Vellum

Perennial Lavender designer series paper Pretty Peacock, Blackberry Bliss, Shaded Spruce, Gorgeous Grape ink Painted Lavender, Hills of Tuscany, Perennial Postage stamps Thoughtful Expressions dies Paper butterflies Iridescent ribbon Blooming pearls Dimensionals Adhesives

General Measurements:

Card base

Z-fold panel

Front panel DSP Z-fold DSP Sentiment/image panel Message panel 5 ½" x 8 ½" score at 4 ¼" 5 ¼" x 8" score at 4" and 6" 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" 1 7/8" x 5 ¼" (2) 2 ¾" x 2 ¾" 3 5/8" x 4 7/8"

Directions:

- 1. Cut 5 ½"x 8 ½" Highland Heather cardstock. Score at 4 ¼".
- 2. Cut 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" sheet of Perennial Lavender designer series paper. Adhere to the front of the card base.
- 3. Select a Thoughtful Expressions die that is approximately 3" in diameter. With the card base open and the die in the center of the DSP section, diecut the shape from the card front. Set aside the 3" diecut piece.
- 4. Adhere a strip of iridescent ribbon center in the section underneath the newly-cut window in the card front.
- 5. Cut 5 ¼" x 8" Gorgeous Grape cardstock. Score at 4" and 6". Fold so that the z-panel is on the right and opens outward toward the right.
- 6. Cut 2 1 7/8" x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " pieces of Perennial Lavender DSP and adhere to the two small panels of the z-fold panel.
- 7. Cut 3 5/8" x 4 7/8" white cardstock. Stamp the sentiment from the Perennial Postage stamp set in Gorgeous Grape ink in the center of the white message panel and adhere to the large panel of the z-fold panel next to the two strips of DSP.
- 8. Adhere the z-panel to the card base by placing adhesive on the back of the message panel and adhering it to the inside card base. The z-fold should open outward toward the right with the card completely open.
- 9. Cut the sentiment panel from vellum using the smaller nesting die from the Thoughtful Expressions die set. Stamp the grassy element and lone lavender stem on the vellum and heat set. Then stamp the sentiment from the Hills of Tuscany stamp set in Pretty Peacock in the center and heat set. Adhere the vellum to the 3" panel with glue dots.
- 10. With the card completely closed, place dimensionals only on the exposed z-fold peeking through the front window of the card. Then, line up the 3" diecut piece with the original hole in the card front, making sure that the Highland Heather cardstock of this piece is facing outward. Adhere this 3" panel to the dimensionals.
- 11. With the card completely closed, adhere a paper butterfly over the top left of the window with glue dots, ensuring that none of the sentiment is obscured by the butterfly.
- 12. Embellish with Pretty Peacock blooming pearls.
