

Song Sparrow PAPERCRAFTS



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DSP Center Folding Door Tutorial



Supplies Needed:

Pool Party, Real Red, Shaded Spruce, Basic White cardstock
Real Red, Cherry Cobbler ink
Sunny Days, More Dazzle DSP
Vellum

Bold Bouquet stamps
Bold Bouquet, Nested Essentials dies
Dimensionals
Foiled gems
Adhesives

General Measurements:

Card base

4 1/4" x 5 1/2"

DSP

5 1/4" x 12"

scored at 2", 4", 8", and 10"

Front card focal panel

3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Front card focal panel mat

4" x 4"

Real Red CS

3" x 3"

Shaded Spruce CS

3" x 3"

More Dazzle SP

1/2 sheet

Directions:

1. Cut 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" base from Pool Party cardstock.

2. Select a sheet of designer series paper. For this design, a sheet of Sunny Days DSP was selected. Cut to 5 ¼" x 12". With the long edge at the top of the trimmer, score at 2", 4", 8" and 10".
3. Make a mark on the short side at 2" and repeat on the opposite short side.
4. With the paper trimmer, cut on the diagonal from the 2" mark on the short side to the 4" score line. This will cut out a triangular piece out of this corner of the DSP. Repeat for the other side. There should be approximately equal triangles cut from each of the corners at the top, similar to the drawing below.



5. Take the 2 triangular pieces and flip them over so the opposite pattern is showing. Adhere each triangle to the bottom corners of the paper with the straight edges lined up. This should also align the score marks.
6. Fold on the score marks. You should have a center section that is 4" x 5 ¼". The two small outer flaps will meet in the center at their folds.
7. Adhere this folding DSP section to the Lost Lagoon base.
8. Assemble the focal point of the card front.
 - a. Using the two largest decorative circles in the Nested Essentials die set, diecut the largest from vellum. Diecut the smaller from white cardstock. Set aside.
 - b. Stamp roses from Bold Bouquet set in Real Red and Cherry Cobbler on Real Red cardstock.
 - c. Diecut roses using the coordinating Bold Bouquet dies. Set aside.
 - d. Diecut flower from More Dazzle SP using the Nested Essentials die. Set aside.
 - e. Using the Nested Essentials dies, diecut leaves and stems from Shaded Spruce cardstock.
 - f. Assemble roses and greenery on white cardstock panel. Vary height using dimensionals.
 - g. Adhere the white panel to the vellum panel using dimensionals, making sure that all dimensionals are adhered so they do not show through the vellum.
9. Adhere the focal point to the left flap only so that the card will open properly.
10. Embellish with Petal Pink foiled gems as desired.
11. For the inside message panel, adhere a piece of white paper to the DSP card base. I chose not to have any white from my message panel show through to the card front, making my message panel approximately 3 ¾" x 4". I finished it with a narrow strip of More Dazzle SP at the top.
