

Double Fold-Over Panel Fold Tutorial





Supplies Needed:

Mossy Meadow, Soft Sea Foam, Calypso Coral, Flirty Flamingo, Pumpkin Pie, Daffodil Delight, Basic White cardstock Basic Black ink Flowering Zinnias DSP Inspiring Snapdragons, Something
Fancy stamps
Simply Zinnia, Nested Essentials dies
Paper butterflies
Shiny sequins, sequins trio
Dimensionals
Adhesives


General Measurements:

Card base	8 ½" x 5 ½" scored at 4 ¼"
DSP 1	2" x 5 ½"
Mat for DSP 1	4 ½" x 5 ½"
Sentiment Mat 1	
Sentiment Mat 2	
Front & Inside Sentiment Panel	4 ½" x 5 ½"

Directions:

Card Base & Front

- 1. Cut an 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" sheet of Mossy Meadow cardstock in half so that you have 2 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " bases. Score 1 card base at 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " and fold. Set aside the other card base for now.
- 2. Place the scored card base flat so that the score line runs vertically. To the right of the score line, place a pencil mark at $1\frac{1}{4}$ " at the top and at 2" at the bottom.



3. Line up each of your pencil marks on your paper trimmer and cut between them so that you are creating a small diagonal panel for your card front. Set aside the other piece for now.

- 4. Cut an 8 ½" x 11" sheet of Soft Sea Foam cardstock in half. Cut the 5 ½" x 8 ½" piece in half again so that you have 2 quarter-sheets measuring 4 ¼" x 5 ½". Set aside one quarter-panel for now.
- 5. Line up the Soft Sea Foam quarter-sheet so that the short edge is on the bottom. Place a pencil mark at the top of the sheet 1 1/8" from the top-left edge and place a pencil mark at 1 7/8" from the bottom-left edge.
- 6. Line up each of your pencil marks on your paper trimmer and cut between them so that you are creating a small diagonal mat. Set aside the other piece for now.
- 7. Cut a 2" x 5 ¼" strip of the stems and leaves pattern sheet from the Flowering Zinnias paper pack.
- 8. Line up the DSP strip so that the short edge is on the bottom and the pattern is oriented correctly. Place a pencil mark at the top of the sheet 1" from the top-left edge and place a pencil mark at 1 3/4" from the bottom-left edge.
- 9. Line up each of your pencil marks on your paper trimmer and cut between them so that you are creating a small diagonal piece that has even matting on all sides when sitting atop the Soft Sea Foam mat and Mossy Meadow flap.

Front & Inside Sentiment Panel


- 10. Using the portion of the Mossy Meadow quarter-sheet that was removed from the card front, diecut the second-largest hexagon using the Nested Essentials dies.
- 11. Using the portion of the Soft Sea Foam quarter sheet that was removed for the card front mat, diecut the second-largest hexagon using the Nested Essentials dies.
- 12. Remove an approximately 1/8" strip from the center of the Soft Sea Foam hexagon so that there is a small border of Mossy Meadow when these two hexagons are layered together. Remove more from the center as needed to achieve this small border.
- 13. Adhere the Soft Seafoam hexagon to the Mossy Meadow hexagon, ensuring there is a small border around the top and bottom edge and that the center seam of the Soft Sea Foam is barely visible.
- 14. On the 4 ¼" x 5 ½" sheet of white cardstock, stamp the sentiment from Inspiring Snapdragons and then diecut using the second-smallest hexagon from the Nested Essentials dies.
- 15. Adhere the white hexagon sentiment panel to the green hexagon panels, ensuring an even border of Soft Sea Foam all around the white sentiment panel.
- 16. Adhere the full sentiment panel to the small front card flap using tear-n-tape to ensure a secure hold.
- 17. On the sheet of white cardstock, stamp the sentiment from Something Fancy and then diecut using the second-smallest hexagon from the Nested Essentials dies.

18. Open the small front fold-over. Adhere this sentiment panel to the back of the Meadow Moss hexagon so that it is now a two-sided sentiment panel.



Inside Fold-Over Panel

- 19. Cut a 5 ¼" x 5 ½" piece of Mossy Meadow cardstock.
- 20. Line up the short side of the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " sheet on your score mat and score at 1". Your piece of cardstock should now look like this:



21. Adhere the scored sheet to the card base using the 1-inch flap. Tear-n-tape is the recommended adhesive as it has a firm hold and will be able to support greater use. The score line of this panel should be on the right edge of the card base, creating your inside fold-over panel.

22. Cut a 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" piece of white paper. Open the inside fold-over panel to reveal the inside card base. Adhere the white paper to the card base, which should cover almost all of the 1-inch flap of the inside fold-over panel.



- 23. Take the second quarter-sheet of Soft Sea Foam and cut down to 4 1/8" x 5 3/8".
- 24. Cut the full stem zinnia pattern sheet from the Flowering Zinnias paper pack down the center so that the white section is cut in two, leaving 2 identical pieces of DSP that are 6" x 12". Set one piece aside.
- 25. Cut a 4" x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece of the zinnia pattern and adhere to the Soft Sea Foam mat. Then adhere this panel to the front of the inside fold-over panel.



Embellishments

- 26. Cut a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" panel of Calypso Coral and Flirty Flamingo cardstock. Use the blossom dies from the Simply Zinnia dies to cut flower blossom layers from each color. Using one of each blossom pattern, adhere together using a dimensional and set aside.
- 27. Cut a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" panel of Pumpkin Pie and Daffodil Delight cardstock. Using the center and mini ring floret dies, cut floral centers from Pumpkin Pie and mini ring florets from Daffodil Delight. If desired, finish with a shiny sequin in the very center. Adhere to the blossoms using glue dots.
- 28. Adhere one zinnia blossom to the front, angled fold-over panel towards the top, allowing some free overhang of the petals over the DSP panel behind.

- 29. Adhere another zinnia blossom to the inside DSP fold-over panel so that a portion of the zinnia peaks up and behind the front sentiment panel.
- 30. From the blossom-only pattern sheet of Flowering Zinnias designer paper, cut one flower from the edge of the paper using paper snips. Adhere a mini ring floret to the partial blossom and add a shiny sequin to the center.
- 31. Adhere the partial blossom to the left side of the front sentiment panel, carefully covering the visible center seam of the Soft Sea Foam mat.
- 32. Adhere a small paper butterfly to the right side of the front sentiment panel using layers of dimensionals.
- 33. Place shiny sequins and white sequins from the sequins trio set across the visible card front, ensuring that some sequins will be visible on the inside fold-over panel once the sentiment flap has been opened.
