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Faux Fold-Over Fun Fold Tutorial



Supplies Needed:

Early Espresso, Basic White cardstock
Country Woods, In Color Luster DSP
Copper Clay, Early Espresso ink
Unbounded Love, Something Fancy,
Heartfelt Hexagon stamps
Spotlight on Nature, Autumn Leaves,
Grove dies

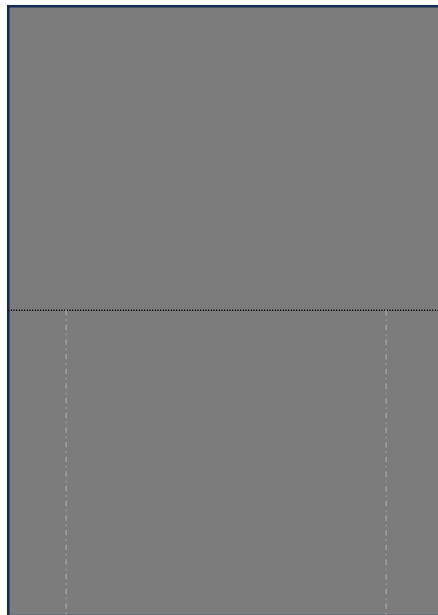
Leaf Fall embossing folder
Linen thread
Swirl dots
Dimensionals
Adhesives

General Measurements:

Card base	8 ½" x 5 ½" scored at 4 ¼"
DSP 1	4 1/8" x 5 3/8"
DSP 2	3" x 6"
Pebble Path Luster	3 3/8" x 4"
Copper Clay Luster	2 ½" x 4"
Basic White cardstock	2" x 2" (1) 3 3/8" x 4" (1)

Directions:

1. Cut Early Espresso cardstock to 8 ½" x 5 ½". Score at 4 ¼".
2. Line up the short edge of the cardstock on the top of your paper trimmer. Line up the long edge at 1". Make a cut from the bottom edge to the score mark in the center.
3. Flip the cardstock 180 degrees to line up the opposite short edge on the top of your paper trimmer. Line up the long edge at 1". Make a cut from the bottom edge to the score mark in the center. Your card base should now look like this:



4. Using tear-n-tape, adhere the 1-inch strips of the card front to the base. Only the center section of the card front should open/close. This is your faux fold-over panel.
5. Using the Pool Party woodgrain pattern sheet from the Country Woods designer series paper pack (DSP 1), cut a 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" piece. With the long edge on the top of the paper trimmer, cut a 7/8" strip from both the left and right sides. Be sure you keep the pieces in their original order so the woodgrain pattern matches perfectly once all three pieces are adhered to the card front.

6. Apply adhesive to the back of both small strips. Adhere each one to the appropriate strip on the card front, leaving an even 1/16" border on three sides. The remaining side of each strip will meet the larger panel of DSP in the center. When the card is closed, this will give you the look of one continuous sheet of the Pool Party woodgrain pattern.
7. Next, using your embossing machine and the Leaf Fall embossing folder, emboss the Pebble Path luster paper panel. Align the panel in the embossing folder so that you have the least amount of unembossed space on the edges. Using tear-n-tape, adhere the embossed panel to the center fold-over panel.
8. Using the white woodgrain pattern from the Country Woods Designer Series paper pack (DSP 2), you will diecut two nesting circles using the Spotlight on Nature dies. The largest circle should be cut so that the white woodgrain is facing up. The smaller, nesting circle should be cut so that the other side of the paper with the brown woodgrain pattern is facing up.
9. From the smaller piece of white cardstock, diecut a smaller nesting circle. In the center of the circle, stamp the sentiment from Unbounded Love in Copper Clay ink. Adhere this circle to the brown woodgrain circle.
10. Apply dimensionals to the back of the sentiment panel and adhere to the white woodgrain circle. Apply dimensionals to the back of this stacked panel. Set aside.
11. From the Copper Clay luster paper, you will diecut the doe and fawn deer from the Grove die set, both twigs with leaves from the Grove die set, and a maple leaf from the Autumn Leaves die set.
12. Using linen thread, make a bow shape (no need to knot it) large enough to be visible on either side under the stacked circle panel. Adhere the linen bow to the center of the embossed panel with glue dots.
13. Remove the backing from the dimensionals on the stacked circle panel and adhere over the linen thread bow.
14. Apply dimensionals to the back of the doe deer diecut and adhere at the bottom-right of the fold-over panel so that her feet touch the bottom of the embossed panel.
15. Apply dimensionals to the back of the fawn deer diecut so that it will stand a level higher than the doe. This should require two dimensionals at the back and one dimensional toward the front-center. Adhere over the doe so that the front shoulders of the fawn are just over mom's legs.
16. Apply adhesive to the back of each of the twigs. Adhere over the top-left of the sentiment circle so that the leaves are coming down toward the sentiment, like they are pointing to it.
17. Using dimensionals, affix the maple leaf over the twigs with its stem pointed upward toward the score line.
18. Finish the card front with Pecan Pie swirl dots.
19. On the larger white cardstock panel, stamp the leaves from Heartfelt Hexagon in Copper Clay ink in the bottom-right corner using the stamp-off method so that you ink the stamp heavily and then stamp off a layer of ink on scrap paper before stamping the image on your inside sentiment panel. Do this three times, alternating the position of the stamped leaves each time.

20. In Early Espresso ink, stamp the sentiment from Something Fancy over the leaves. Adhere the sentiment panel to the inside panel of the card.
