Diamond Fold Fun Fold Tutorial





Supplies Needed:

Shaded Spruce, Mossy Meadow, Very Vanilla cardstock Season of Green & Gold, Gold Foil DSP

Peaceful Evergreens*, Adventurous Sky stamps

Peaceful Evergreens*, Peaceful Season* dies
Black, Mossy Meadow ink
Glue dots
Drusy embellishments*
Dimensionals
Adhesives



General Measurements:

Card base	11" x 4 1/4"
	scored at 5 ½" and 8 7/8"
Diamond panel	3" x 3"
DSP 1	4 ½" x 5 ¾"
DSP 2	3 ¼" x 4 ¼"
	2 7/8" x 2 7/8"
Tree panel	4 ½" x 5 ½"
Gold panel	4 ½" x 5 ½"
Sentiment panel	3" x 3"

Directions:

- 1. Cut Shaded Spruce cardstock 11" x 4 1/4". Score at 5 1/2" and 8 7/8".
- 2. On smallest panel short edge, make a mark at the halfway point (2 1/8"). Cut from the score line at 8 7/8" to the center mark on the short edge at 2 1/8" on both sides of the paper. This transforms the panel into a triangle by removing the blue portions in the diagram below.



- 3. Fold on each of the score lines. The largest portion will be the back base of the card. The triangle panel will fold back over the front of the card.
- 4. Choose two coordinating patterns of patterned paper. For this card, I've selected the mistletoe and greenery pattern and the metallic gold fleck patterns from the Season of Green & Gold designer series paper pack. DSP 1 will be visible when

- the card is fully closed. DSP 2 will be the center of the diamond and serve as the inside decorative panel.
- 5. Cut DSP 1 to $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{3}{4}$ ". With the long edge at the top of the paper trimmer, cut at $3\frac{1}{4}$ " to give you 2 panels of DSP 1 one will be $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " and the other will be $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ ".
- 6. Adhere the 3 ¹/₄" DSP 1 to the front panel of the card.
- 7. Adhere the 2 ½" DSP 1 to the right side of the inside message panel of the card. When the card is closed, it will appear that the DSP 1 meets in the middle.
- 8. Cut a piece of white paper to size and adhere next to the DSP 1 panel on the right side of the inside message panel.
- 9. Cut gold foil specialty paper to 4 ¼" x 5 ½". From there, cut a 3" x 3" square. Apply adhesive to the triangle flap on the front of the card and adhere the gold square. With the card closed, you know have a gold diamond in the center of DSP 1.
- 10. Cut DSP 2 to 3 ¼" x 4 ¼". Adhere to the inside panel of the card that is closest to the score line and covered by the gold diamond when the card is open.
- 11. Cut another piece of DSP 2 to 2 7/8" x 2 7/8". Adhere to gold diamond.
- 12. Cut Mossy Meadow cardstock to 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Stamp the largest tree from Peaceful Evergreens in Mossy Meadow ink . Diecut using the coordinating Peaceful Evergreens die. Adhere to center of diamond panel using dimensionals.
- 13. Cut bow from gold foil specialty paper using the Peaceful Evergreens bow dies.



14. Assemble the bow, using glue dots to adhere each layer. Then adhere the fully assembled bow to the top of the tree using a glue dot.

- 15. Diecut the largest fancy banner from the Peaceful Season die set from the gold foil specialty paper.
- 16.Cut a 3" x 3" piece of Very Vanilla cardstock. Stamp the sentiment from Adventurous Sky in black ink. Diecut using the smallest rectangle banner from the Peaceful Season dies. Adhere the sentiment panel to the center of the gold fancy banner. Apply dimensionals to the center of the back of the panel and adhere to the bottom of the tree.
- 17. Add Drusy Embellishments as desired on the front of the card.
