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## Z-Fold Pop-Up Card



### Supplies Needed:

Melon Mambo, Basic Black, Basic White cardstock  
Lovely Garden, pastel ombre glimmer, In Color glimmer, three color glimmer DSP  
Beautiful Butterflies, Something Fancy dies  
Pattern of Friendship stamps

Window sheet  
Melon Mambo ink  
Iridescent faceted gems  
Dimensionals  
Adhesives

### General Measurements:

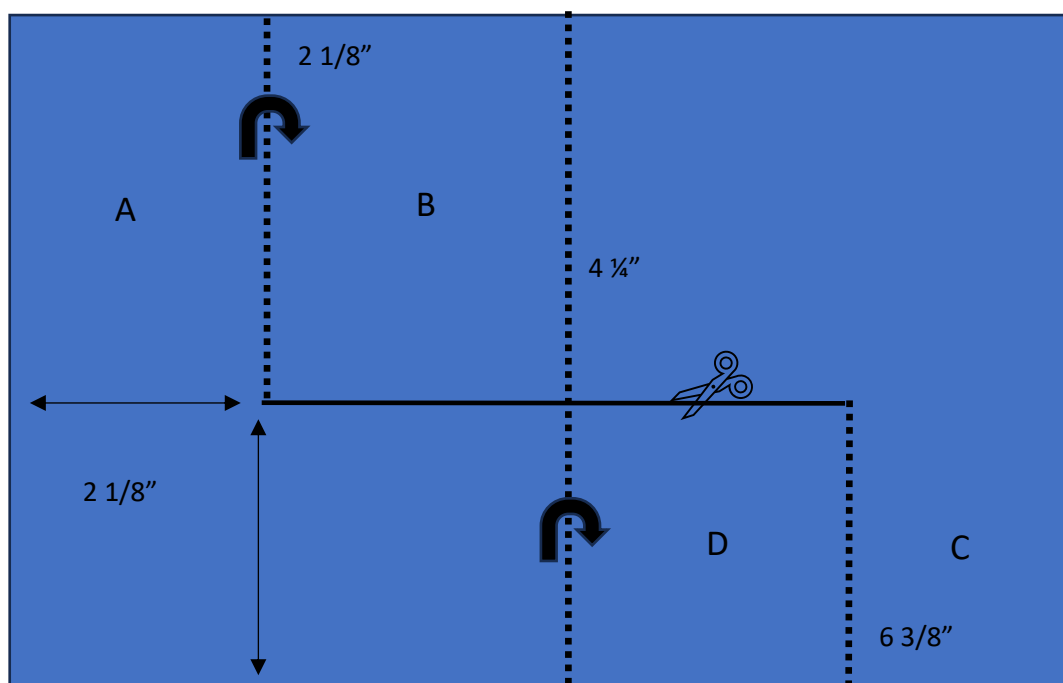
Card base

Lovely Garden DSP  
Peach Pie glimmer  
Basic Black  
Basic White, glimmer papers  
Window sheet

4 1/4" x 8 1/2" Melon Mambo cardstock  
scored at 4 1/4"  
4 1/4" x 5 1/2"  
4 1/4" x 5 1/2"  
4 1/4" x 5 1/2"  
scraps  
3/4" x 3" (x 2)

## Directions:

1. Cut Melon Mambo cardstock  $5\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$ ". Score at  $4\frac{1}{4}$ ".
2. Score and cut as shown below.
  - a. With the long edge at the top, make a pencil mark at  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " on the left and bottom. Make a pencil mark at  $6\frac{3}{8}$ " on the bottom.
  - b. With the short edge at the top of the trimmer, line up at  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " which should line up with a pencil mark. Cut between the pencil marks at  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " and  $6\frac{3}{8}$ ", which should be on the left side of your cardstock.
  - c. With the long edge at the top of your score board, score up from the slit at  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " and score down from the slit at  $6\frac{3}{8}$ ".
3. Fold the outer edges toward the center.
  - a. The left score mark at  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " will fold up, along with the bottom portion of the center score mark at  $4\frac{1}{4}$ ".
  - b. The top portion of the center score mark will fold in, along with the right score mark at  $6\frac{3}{8}$ ".
4. Your card base should be in a Z shape with a center square.



5. Choose two coordinating patterns from the Lovely Garden paper pack. Cut each to  $4 \times 5\frac{1}{4}$ ".
  - a. Open the card base and lay it out flat.
  - b. Decide which sheet of DSP will be front-facing when the card is closed. Lay it over the left side of the open card base and mark where it should be cut to cover panel A and panel B.
  - c. Adhere panel A and panel B to the card base.

- d. Do the same with the sheet of DSP that will be inside the card. Lay it over the right side of the open card base and mark where it should be cut to cover panel C and panel D.
  - e. Adhere panel C and panel D to the card base.
6. Use scrap piece of white cardstock to cut the smallest scallop tag using the Something Fancy dies. Cut it so that it just covers the top left corner of panel A.
7. Stamp the sentiment from Pattern of Friendship in Melon Mambo on the scallop tag. Adhere to the card front.
8. Using the large butterfly and small butterfly from the Beautiful Butterflies die set, cut a large and small butterfly from Peach Pie glimmer paper.
9. Using the small butterfly die, cut a butterfly from pink and blue pastel ombre glimmer paper and from Pretty Peacock glimmer paper (or repeat from pastel ombre).
10. Using the large wing detail and small wing detail dies from Beautiful Butterflies, cut one large detail section from Basic Black cardstock and four small detail sections.
11. Using the large body and small body dies from Beautiful Butterflies, cut one large body and four large body sections from Basic Black cardstock.
12. Next, assemble the butterflies.
  - a. Adhere the large wing detail and body to the large Peach Pie butterfly.
  - b. Adhere a small wing detail and body to each of the smaller butterflies. You should have one small Peach Pie, pink ombre, blue ombre, and Pretty Peacock butterfly when finished.
13. Cut a window sheet into two small strips measuring  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 3". *TIP: you can save the acetate sheets from your photopolymer stamp sets and use them in place of window sheets.*
14. Place a small butterfly on top of another with the strip of acetate window sheet in between so that the decorative sides are facing out. You'll be using the two-sided smaller butterflies as the pop-up elements for your card.
15. Fold the card closed to determine the placement of the large and small butterflies.
  - a. The small butterflies will be adhered to the back side of the right-bottom small panel. Adhere them in a way where both butterflies are visible whether the card is open or closed. It helps to adhere them at an angle.
  - b. Adhere the large butterfly with dimensionals to the bottom portion of the front card panel. The large butterfly should not hide either of the smaller butterflies.
16. Embellish with iridescent faceted gems.
