## Explosion Pop-Up Fun Fold Tutorial



### Supplies Needed:

Pool Party, Basic White cardstock  
Wildflower Birthday patterned paper & ephemera  
Textured Notes Dies  
Spotlight on Nature dies  
The Right Words stamps

Pool Party ink  
Gold striped mesh ribbon  
Drusy embellishments  
Dimensionals  
Adhesives

### General Measurements:

Card base

DSP 1

DSP 2

White cardstock

Pop-up panel

5 1/2" x 8 1/2" Pool Party cardstock

Scored at 4 1/4"

4" x 5 1/2" pink plaid

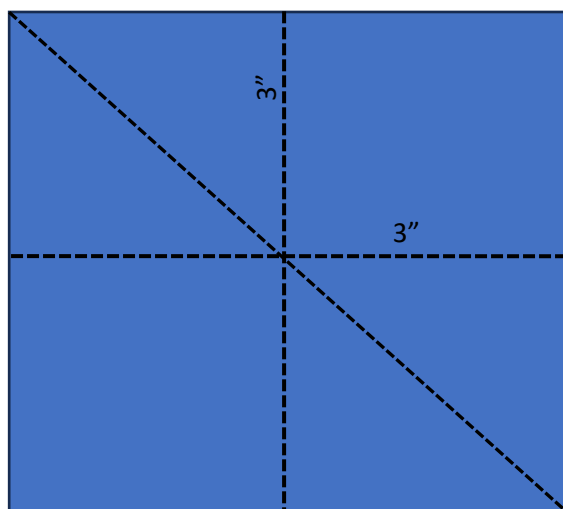
3 1/2 x 4" Pool Party & gold

2 3/4" x 2 3/4"

6" x 6"

## Directions:

1. Cut Pool Party cardstock 5 ½ x 8 ½" and score at 4 ¼" to create the card base.
2. Cut a piece of pink plaid Wildflower Birthday patterned paper to 4" x 5 ½" and use the largest Textured Notes die to cut.
3. Cut a piece of the Pool Party & gold metallic patterned paper to 3 ½" x 4" and use one of the second-largest circle dies from Spotlight on Nature die set to cut.
4. Make a doubled faux bow out of gold striped mesh ribbon and affix on the diagonal to the pink plaid rectangle panel.
5. Affix several layers of dimensionals onto the back of each corner of the circle die and affix over the bow in the center of the panel.
6. Choose a cake from the Wildflower Birthday ephemera pack and affix it to the circle panel with dimensionals.
7. Affix the fully assembled panel to the card base with a layer of dimensionals.
8. Finish the card front with drusy embellishments.
9. Cut a sheet of the striped patterned paper to 6" x 6".
10. Score at 3" on both sides and then score on the diagonal.



11. Fold inward on both of the 3" score lines.
12. Fold outward on the diagonal score line.
13. Holding the solid squares (no scores) on the right and left, pull the corners together so that the two scored squares fold toward one another in the middle and all 4 points of the edges meet forming the closed square pop-up panel.
14. Press the square to fully crease each of the score lines and make the pop-up open and close easily.
15. Apply tear-n-tape to the back of each unscored square.
16. Remove the backing on one side with the pop-up panel closed.
17. Apply on the left-inside panel of the card so that each of the edge points meets the edge of the card and the center score line.

18. With the card base in your left hand and keeping the pop-up panel closed, remove the backing from the tape on the other side of the pop-up panel.
19. Fold the right panel of the card base toward the exposed adhesive on the pop-up panel and adhere to the right-inside panel of the card.
20. Press the closed card together firmly to ensure the adhesive is fully adhered to each side of the inside panel.
21. Open the card, which should open the pop-up panel. NOTE: The 6" x 6" sheet will be on the diagonal inside the card when the pop-up panel is fully extended.
22. Cut a piece of white cardstock to 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ ".
23. Using a birthday sentiment from The Right Words stamp set, stamp on the white panel (turned diagonally) in Pool Party ink.
24. Adhere a gold banner ephemera piece on the diagonal over the top of the opposing panel from the sentiment.
25. Adhere a piece of cake slightly offset of center of the opposing square from the sentiment panel.
26. Add drusy embellishments, if desired.
