

## **Dutch Door Fold Card**





## Supplies Needed:


Cloud Cover, Blackberry Bliss, Mossy Meadow, Basic White cardstock Lights of Aurora, pastel ombre glimmer DSP Light & Wonder stamps & dies Versamark Black embossing powder Frosted iridescent dots Dimensionals Adhesives

## General Measurements:

Card base DSP Glimmer paper Cardstock 1 Cardstock 2 White 5 ½" x 8 ½" Cloud Cover 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" 1" x 4" Blue pastel ombre 4" x 5 ½" Blackberry Bliss 4" x 5 ½" Mossy Meadow 4" x 5 ¼"

## Directions:

- 1. Cut Cloud Cover cardstock 5 ½ x 8 ½". Score at 4 ¼" and fold.
- 2. Cut as shown below.
  - a. With the short edge on top, cut from the edge of the paper to the center score line at 1 1/4" from each edge of the paper.



- 3. Cut a piece of white cardstock 4" x 5 1/4" and adhere to the inside card panel.
- 4. Select a piece of cardstock to serve as the background of the card front. Here, I've selected a sheet of blue paper from the Lights of Aurora paper pack. Cut to 4 1/8" x 5 3/8".
- 5. With the long edge on top, cut a 1  $\frac{1}{4}$ " strip from each end. Then trim each of these strips to 1  $\frac{1}{8}$ ".
- 6. Adhere the cut DSP background panel to each of the coordinating sections of the card front, leaving a small border around each piece.
- 7. Using a quarter panel of Blackberry Bliss cardstock and the mountain range from the Light & Wonder dies, cut 3 ranges of mountains along the long edge.
  - a. HINT: Make sure that at least 2 of the ranges have sections that will align in the center so the center flap will look similar whether the card is open or closed.
- 8. Using a quarter panel of Mossy Meadow cardstock and the small trees from the Light & Wonder dies, cut 2 stands of trees along the long edge.
- 9. Using the blue pastel ombre glimmer paper and detailed water die from the Light & Wonder dies, cut a section of water.
- 10. Layer 2 sections of mountain range and adhere together using dimensionals, making sure there are no exposed portions on the back.

- 11. Layer the water and trees over the bottom of the mountain range so that it looks like the lake is peeking through the trees and adhere the layers to the mountain range.
- 12. Place the mountain range over the card front to determine placement but do not adhere yet.
- 13. With the mountain range placed, determine where you will stamp the sentiment on the center panel.
- 14. Stamp the sentiment selected from the Light & Wonder set in Versamark and then heat emboss with black embossing powder.
- 15. Now adhere the mountain range in place using dimensionals.
  - a. Do NOT adhere the center of the mountain range to anything.
  - b. You want the two side flaps of the card front to function as one piece connected by the sides of the mountain range, while the center section of the card front remains free to open and close separately.
- 16. Lift the connected front panel to reveal the center portion with the sentiment.
- 17. Using the remaining section of mountain range and trees, affix to the center flap and trim to fit.
  - a. NOTE: The mountain range on the center panel should either not be visible when the card is closed OR the visible portion should look like a taller portion of the range in the background. For my card, I chose to have it hidden.
- 18. Finish by using frosted iridescent dots to embellish the card front when it is closed, ensuring that there are dots on all 3 of the front sections.
