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## Flip Flap Fun Fold Tutorial



### Supplies Needed:

Basic Black cardstock  
Spooky Suite DSP and ephemera  
Shimmer star foam stickers

Wink of Stella  
Dimensionals  
Adhesives

### General Measurements:

Card base

DSP 1

Flaps

Anchor flip panel

5 1/2" x 8 1/2" Basic Black cardstock

Scored at 4 1/4"

Scene panel from Spooky Suite paper

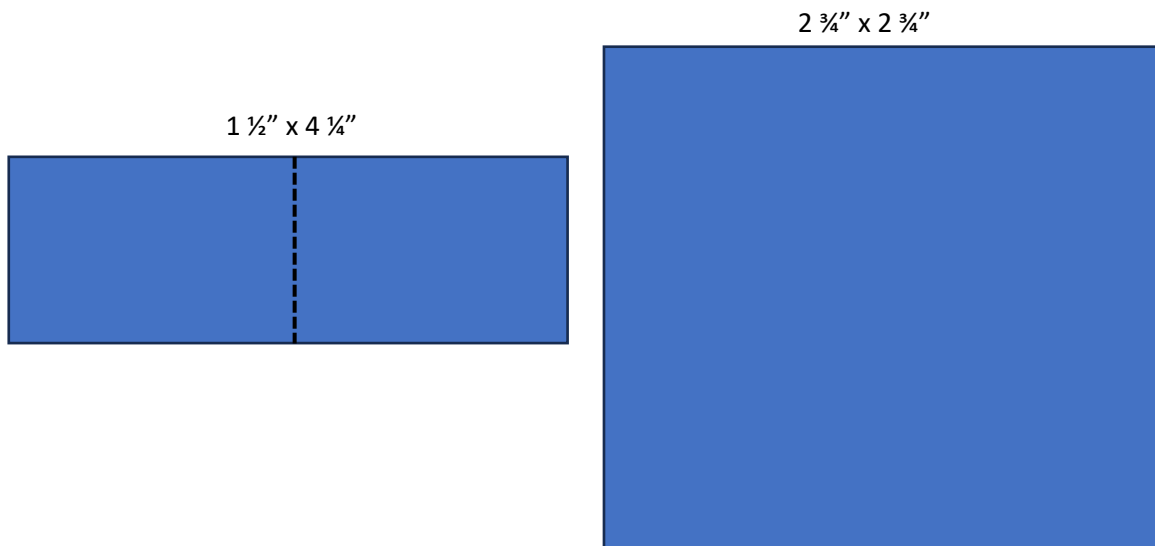
2 3/4" x 2 3/4" (x2)

1 1/2" x 4 1/4"

Scored at 2 1/8"

## Directions:

1. Cut Basic Black cardstock  $5\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$ " and score at  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " to create the card base.
2. Cut a quarter panel of Basic Black ( $4\frac{1}{4} \times 5\frac{1}{2}$ ").
  - a. With the long edge on top, cut the panel in half so that you have two  $2\frac{3}{4} \times 4\frac{1}{4}$ " pieces.
  - b. With the long edge on top, cut at  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " so that you now have 2 squares.
3. Cut a second quarter panel of black.
  - a. With the short edge on top, cut at  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " so that you have a  $1\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{4}$ " strip.
  - b. With the long edge on top, score at  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " and fold to set the crease.



4. Choose and cut one of the quarter-panel scenes from the scene sheet in the Spooky Sweet paper pack. Adhere to the front panel of the card base.



5. From the Spooky Sweet ephemera sheet, choose characters and elements to build 3 scenes—1 scene on the card front and 2 scenes for the flap.

- a. I chose to cut the bat ghost character from the multi-character patterned sheet in the paper pack for the card front, along with a few bats from the ephemera sheet.
- b. For the flaps, I chose the tree, fairy, and bats from the ephemera pack and then cut the flamingo ballerina from the character sheet.



6. Using dimensionals, adhere the bat ghost character to the front panel, placing it on the sidewalk in front of the door.
7. Mock up the placement of the fold-over flap—high enough that the square panel covers the bat ghost.
8. Adhere the scored flap to the inside panel so that it will be in the center of the squares. Then adhere the squares on either side of the flap panel to create the full two-sided flap.
9. Both sides of the flap will begin with trees from the ephemera pack.
10. The ballerina flamingo is in front of the tree on the front-facing flap with a trick-or-treat bat in the top-left corner. These characters work together to cover the scene on the card front behind the flap when it's closed.
11. The fairy bear is in front of the tree on the inside-facing flap with a trick-or-treat bat (flying the opposite direction) adhered directly over the bat on the front so that this character is now two-sided.
12. I added a few smaller bats from the ephemera pack to fill in gaps in the scenes.
13. Wink of Stella gives some extra twinkle to the ballerina and fairy characters.
14. Add a message panel to the inside panel of the card. Add a strip of Spooky Sweet paper for a little extra pop.
15. Embellish with foam glitter stars as desired.
