Gift Trio Box Tutorial





Supplies Needed (DSP version - shown):

Reindeer Days DSP Reindeer Days Memories & More pack Real Red cardstock Dimensionals

DSP

Adhesives Hand cream Lindor truffle Pocket sanitizer

General Measurements (DSP version):

Cardstock $1x 6 \frac{1}{4}$ " $x 1 \frac{5}{8}$ "

Score 6 1/4" side at 2 3/4", 3 5/8", and 4 1/2"

1x 4 ½" x 4 7/8"

Score 4 7/8" side at 1 ½", 2 3/8", and 3 ¼"

8 3/8" x 9 ½"

Score 8 3/8" side at 1" and 2" from each side Score 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " side at 1" and 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side

General Measurements (cardstock version):

Cardstock $1 \times 6^{1/4}$ " x 1 5/8"

Score 6 1/4" side at 2 3/4", 3 5/8", and 4 1/2"

1x 4 ½" x 4 7/8"

Score 4 7/8" side at 1 ½", 2 3/8", and 3 ¼"1x 8 3/8" x 9 ½"

Score 8 3/8" side at 1" and 2" from each side Score 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " side at 1" and 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side

1x 3 1/8" x 4 ½"


2x 7/8" x 4 ½"

2x 7/8" x 3 1/8"

Directions: Creating the Box

1. Cut the selected 12x12 DSP sheet to 85/8" x $9\frac{1}{2}$ ".

- 2. On the 8 5/8" inch side, score at 1" and 2".
 - a. Rotate the sheet 180-degrees and score again at 1" and 2".
 - b. This will score the sheet on the 8 5/8" side at 1" and 2" from both the left and right side of the paper.
- 3. On the 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " side, score at 1" and 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
 - a. Rotate the sheet 180-degrees and score again at 1" and 4 1/4".
 - b. This will score the sheet on the 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " side at 1" and 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " from both the left and right side of the paper.
- 4. Remove the sections marked with an X as shown below.

- 5. Make small angular cuts on each of the box flaps so they look like the diagram above.
- 6. Next, with the selected pattern on the bottom, fold up on all of the score lines.
- 7. With the selected pattern facing up, place tear-n-tape on each of the small flaps marked with a 1.
- 8. On the opposite side of the paper, place tear-n-tape on each of the flaps marked 2a.
- 9. Remove the tape backing from the small flaps and adhere each small flap (1) to the inside of the box onto the flap marked 2b.
 - a. This forms the bottom of the box.
- 10. Remove the tape backing from the 2a panels and fold down and adhere to 2b.
 - a. This will cover the small flaps to create a clean look inside the box.
- 11. The flaps marked with 3 will come down and tuck inside the box.
 - a. *Optional:* Flap **3a** can stay outside the box when the box is closed. You can provide closure for this flap with a Velcro dot.

Creating the Inside Dividers

- 12. Cut a full piece of 8.5x11 Real Red cardstock in half along the long edge.
- 13. Cut piece 1 to 4 ½" x 4 7/8".
 - a. Score along the 4 7/8" side at 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 2 3/8", and 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
 - b. Fold along the score lines so that the center score line comes up to create the divider.
 - c. Place tear-n-tape on the back in between the divider piece to keep it standing in place.
 - d. Place tear-n-tape along the back and then affix to the bottom of the box.
- 14. Cut piece 2 to 1 5/8" x 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
 - a. Score along the 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ " side at 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ ", 3 5/8", and 4 $\frac{1}{2}$.
 - b. Fold along the score lines so that the center score line comes up to create the divider.
 - c. Place tear-n-tape on the back in between the divider piece to keep it standing in place.
 - d. Place in the wider section of the box to create the subdivided section.

Decorating the Box (cardstock version)

- 15. Cut selected DSP pattern to 3 1/8" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and affix to the top of the box.
- 16. Select a coordinating DSP pattern. Cut a strip 7/8" wide.
- 17. Cut 2 sections that are $4\frac{1}{2}$ " long. Adhere to back spine of the box and the front of the lid flap.
- 18. Cut 2 sections that are 3 1/8" long. Adhere to each side of the box.
- 19. Choose a coordinating Memories & More card and affix to the inside of the box lid.
- 20. Choose decorative elements from the DSP sticker sheet to decorate the box top. Use dimensionals to help them stand out.

Filling the Box

- 21. Place hand cream in the long section of the box.
- 22. Place a Lindor truffle in the smaller section of the box.
- 23. Place a pocket sanitizer in the last section.
